Facility for washing crockery students - Ramanathan Hall

Ramanathan hall houses more than 1,000 first year undergraduates from all eight faculties. As cooking is no longer allowed inside the rooms, students have to take their food from the canteen. The students, however, are not provided with adequate facilities to wash used crockery. The AAUP intends to provide a series of large metal sinks, racks to stack plates and soap dispensers. A convenient place has been identified and the estimated cost of the projects is 700,000 LKR.
