INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

1. Tender documents

Tender Documents comprised Instructions to Tenderers, Form of Tender, and General Conditions of Tender, Specifications, Specimen Form of Bid Bond and Specimen Form of Performance Bond.

Tenders should be made on the documents obtainable from the University of Peradeniya, on payment of a non - refundable Tender fee of Rs. 2,000.00 to the Shroff, University of Peradeniya. A Photostat copy of the official receipt of the non-refundable Tender fee should be attached to the Tender.

Tenderer should follow the formats given in the Tender documents for the preparation of the Tender. Each page of the Tender document shall be numbered and signed by the Tender.

Tenders duly signed and dated must be submitted in duplicate. They must be placed in separate sealed covers and marked on the top of left corner of the envelop respectively.

3. Closing and opening of Tenders

Tenders will be closed at 10.00 a.m. hours on 09/03/2012. The tenders received after the closing time will be rejected and unopened. Postal or other delays will not be considered as valid reasons for acceptance of late tenders. Tender will be opened at 10.30 a.m on same day.

Tenderer or his one duly authorized representative may present at the time of opening Tenders. The names of Tenderers, price quoted, if discount disclosed etc. will be readout at the tender opening.

4. Language of the Tender

Language of the tender is ENGLISH.

5. Eligible Tenderers

Only the Manufacturers, sole nominated representative/accredited agents of manufacturers for Testing Equipment in the Sri Lankan market are eligible to participate in this tender.

6. Conformity with Tender Condition and Specifications

All the items offered must strictly conformed to the specifications of the Testing Equipment and to the contents of this document. The offer must address itself specifically to the individual feed specifications and state whether the items offered conform or do not conform therewith.

The tenderer shall submit tenders as per the format given at the relevant annexures. Failure to submit the tender in the required format will be rejected.

7. Tender prices and currencies

The tenderer shall quote the total cost of supply in Sri Lankan Rupees. The tenderer shall indicate VAT separately if applicable.

8. Value Added Tax (VAT)

If the tenderer is registered for the purpose of VAT, the amount of VAT claimed should be indicated separately in the bid document, in addition to the net value of the tender, the VAT registration number should be indicated.

If the tenderer is not registered for VAT, the net value of the tender should be indicated in the bid documents and a letter from the Commissioner of Inland Revenue Department, certifying that the tenderer/bidder has not registered for VAT, should be attached with the bid documents.

If the tenderer has not indicated the VAT registration number or not submitted a letter obtained from the Department of Inland Revenue, tender will not be considered for evaluation and will be rejected.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF TENDER

01. Scope of Work:-

Tenders are hereby invited for the Supply of Testing Equipment as per particulars in annexed bill of quantities for the University of Peradeniya, Peradeniya in conformity with the specifications.

02. General :-

- a) Tenderers must acquaint themselves fully with the Conditions of the Tender. No plea of lack of information or insufficient information will be entertained at any time.
- b) The Tenders and any Contract resulting there from shall be governed by and construed according to **Laws of Sri Lanka**.
- c) No Tender may be considered unless all the conditions laid down in the document have been strictly fulfilled.
- d) No interest will be paid on any guarantee or deposits/bonds.

03. Power of Procurement Committee to Accept or Reject Offers :-

- a) Chairman, Procurement Committee reserves the right to reject any or all Tenders or any portion of the Tender without adducing any reason. The Procurement Committee may accept any or all items of the Tender and reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity offered.
- b) It also reserves the right to delete from the Tender any item seems unnecessary or increase or reduce their quantity, if necessary.
- c) The Tenderer should be prepared to accept and execute a portion or any item of the Tender at the rate quoted in the Tender Form against each item.

04. Bid Bond :-

- a) Tender should accompany a Bid Bond / Bid Guarantee for a lump sum amount covering 2% of the total estimated cost. The Bid Bond given should be equivalent to the following lump sum amounts shown in the **Schedule I** for each category of the tender as the case may be irrespective of the existent values. It should be given from a recognized bank valid for 120 days from 09/03/2012 in favor of the Vice-Chancellor, University of Peradeniya. All tenders send without the Bid Bond shall be treated as informal and be rejected.

Tenderers who wish to quote for lesser number of items may submit Bid Bond only for the items quoting.

- b) Failure to submit the Bid Bond at the time or before the closing of the Tender, will result in the Tender being rejected.
- c) Specimen Bid Bond is shown in Annexure "C" (Refer "Specimen Form of Bid Bond")
- d) Bid Bond should be given from a recognized Bank, **Insurance Bond will not be accepted.**

05. Performance Bond :-

- a) Before a formal Agreement is signed, the successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Bond guarantee for 10% of the contract sum from an approved Bank (**Insurance Bond will not be accepted**) in the name of the Vice-Chancellor, University of Peradeniya, Peradeniya and to mortgage and hypothecate the same to the Vice-Chancellor, University of Peradeniya as security with an approved Bank in favour of the Vice-Chancellor, University of Peradeniya for the due and satisfactory completion of the contract and for the payment of all claims to which the Vice-Chancellor, University of Peradeniya may be entitled under the provisions of the Agreement to be entered into.
- b) The Performance Bond shall be in favour of Vice Chancellor, University of Peradeniya.
- c) In the event of default on the part of the Tenderer resulting from breach of agreement of relevant conditions hereto, Vice Chancellor, University of Peradeniya may by written notice terminate the Contract and collect the Performance Bond without recourse to law.
- d) After 120 days of satisfactory completion of the contract, the Performance Bond will be released.

06. Minimum Validity Period of Offer :-

- a) Tenders should be valid and open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of closing of Tenders.
- b) All prices shall be firm and shall not be subject to any price variation within the validity period of the Offer.
- c) Tenders shall not be withdrawn during the period of validity of the Tender.

07. Tender Price Variations :-

Unless otherwise specifically provided no adjustments of the Tender Price shall be made on account of variations on the costs of labor and materials or any other matter affecting the cost to the Contractor in fulfilling his obligations under the Contract.

08. Bidding Data Sheet / Offer Sheet :-

- a) Tenderers shall quote prices for supply and delivery.
- b) Tenderer shall fill in and sign the prescribed form of “Bidding Data Sheet/Offer Sheets”
- c) Offers shall be liable for rejection if Tenderers fail to submit their Offers on the Bidding Data Sheets/Offer Sheets attached to the official Tender Document.
- d) The **all-inclusive** price quote should be the net price after allowing all discounts.
- e) VAT should be shown separately if applicable with the VAT Registration Number.
- f) The prices quoted should be written clearly in ink or typewritten and must be in figures and repeated in words. If there is a discrepancy between the prices stated in figures and words the prices stated in words will be taken as correct.
- g) Any alteration in the Offers should be initialed by the Tenderer, failure to do so will result in the Offer being treated as informal and rejected.

09. Proof of Ability :-

- a) Tenderer shall submit documents or other evidence of their ability to carry out the Contract, indication factors such as experience.
- b) Tenderer shall provide a list of items, **where the Tender Equipment supplied are similar to that offered in this Tender**, including date of supply, contact numbers and names of the Officers in charge of these institutions.
- c) The Company Profile, List of Projects concerned handled during the past and their contract values should be submitted with the Offer.

10. Guarantee:-

The Tenderer guarantees to the Procurement Committee that the Testing Equipment supplied under the Contract will comply strictly with the requirements of the Contract. The Tenderer shall further guarantee that all items supplied by the Tenderer will be new, merchandise of the most suitable grade, and fit for their intended purposes.

11. Delivery and Installation :-

Delivery and Installation of the Testing Equipments are required within 12 weeks from the date of award.

The tenderer will be responsible for the proper packing and should transport the equipments to ensure their safety until the equipment is delivered and accepted. The equipment to be supplied shall be new and unused at the time of delivery. The probable date of delivery should be stated. All other things being equal preference will be given to Offers which specify early delivery. If the Chairman of the Procurement Committee is not satisfied with the delivery period quoted by the successful supplier/s, he may at his discretion decide to split orders among several suppliers.

12. Payment Terms :-

Payments will be made by cheques upon successful supplying and on production of the invoice/invoices, Certificate of Acceptance by the Vice Chancellor or his authorized officer and other relevant documents which are required for the purpose for the payment.

The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and delivery of its tender. The University of Peradeniya will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.

13. Supply Within Agreed Period :-

Should the Tenderer anticipate at any time during the execution of the order that he will be unable to supply within the time specified in his Tender, he shall at once give notice accordingly, in writing to Chairman Procurement Committee University of Peradeniya explaining the cause of the delay.

If an extension is granted, the Tenderer shall supply the items within the extended period. Failure to do so within such extended period, the Chairman Procurement Committee, University of Peradeniya will have the right of terminating the Tender and to encash /enforce the terms of the Performance Bond without prejudice to any other claims that may be lodged in this regard.

If the contractor fails to supply the items within the time period prescribed in the tender, he shall be liable to pay the University of Peradeniya, one (1) percent of the total contract value per every week of delay, subject to a maximum ten (10) of the total contract sum.

14. Assigning and subletting of contract.

- a. The contractor shall not assign or sublet the works, or any part thereof, without the written authority of the University, his obligations to supply the items tendered for and accepted.
- b. If any part of the obligation has been so assigned or sublet by the Tenderer, he shall nevertheless be held responsible for the due performance of the part so assigned or sublet.

15. Termination of the Contract:-

The Chairman, Procurement Committee, University of Peradeniya may without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, written notice of default sent to the Supplier terminate the Contract in whole or part thereof.

If the Contractor fails to make delivery/completion within the time specified or any extension thereof granted by the Chairman, Procurement Committee

OR

If the Contractor fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract

AND

If the Contractor in either of the above circumstances, does not respond within a period of ten (10) days after receipt of the notice of default from the Chairman, specifying the nature of the default(s)

16. Arbitration:-

All disputes arising out of Contract Agreements should be dealt in accordance with the provisions of Arbitration Act. No. 11 of 1995. The place of Arbitration shall be Sri Lanka.

17. Force Majeure:-

Neither party shall be liable for delay or non-performance of contractual obligations caused by war, blockage, revolutions, insurrection, civil commotion, riots, mobilization, strikes, lockouts, act of God, plague, or other epidemic, fire, flood, obstructions of navigation by ice at port of dispatch, acts of government or public enemy.
